Lauren's Garden was established in April of 1999. At that time the business was started with a 200 square foot greenhouse and has grown to 12,500 square feet with plans of an additional increase of 3,6000 square feet. What once started as a hobby to help pay for plants in the owners' yard has turned into a full-time labor of love. Plant production begins in late January and runs until Christmas, leaving only a short time to prepare for the next growing season. They grow their own bedding plants, hanging baskets, perennials, mums, and poinsettias. Tree and shrubs are brought in from two growers out of state.
